2009 School Prices and Services

Tuition

- Registration and textbook fee: 21,000 yen

Intensive Courses

- Standard Conversational Japanese course (20 lessons per week): 31,500 yen per week
- Special courses (25 lessons per week): 39,900 yen per week
(applies to Japanese and Traditional Culture, Japanese Through Pop Culture, WWOOF Japanese, Japanese for Exams, and Activity Course)

Additional Classes

- Group conversation classes: 2,100 yen per 50-minute class. Book 1-5 classes per week.
- Private classes: 4,200 yen per 50-minute class. Book 1-10 classes per week.
- Exam Skills option: 2,100 yen per class. 1 class held each week, on Fridays. Prepares students planning to take Japanese exams.
- Applications less than a month before the requested start date are subject to a 10,000 yen Express Fee.

Accommodation

Accommodation placement fee: 10,500 yen

Accommodation types:

- 1) dormitory (private room in dorm with Japanese university students). 5 dorms are available, all with different costs:
Per week: 10,000~14,100 yen. Additional night: 1,500~2,000 yen. Breakfast: 300~500 yen.
Dinner: 500~700 yen.
- 2) Shared apartment (private room in a Japanese person's apartment, no breakfast)
Per week: 10,000 yen. Additional night: 1,500 yen
- 3) host family (private room in Japanese family's house, breakfast included):
Per week: 14,000 yen. Additional night: 2,000 yen. (Please note: half-board is not offered as a pre-booking option. Students must arrange dinner directly with the host family.)
- 4) private apartment (one-room private apartment in center of city, walking distance to school, no

meals included). Various apartment available, all with different costs:

Per week: 21,000~30,000 yen/week with high-speed Internet access. Additional night: about 3,000 yen

Discount

Tuition discount

To qualify for a tuition discount, students must meet the following conditions:

1. Same start date and length of study
2. Same course of study
3. Roughly same level of Japanese ability

If students meet these conditions, discounts are available off tuition only (not accommodation), as follows:

2 students: 10%

3 students: 15%

4 students or more: 20%

Accommodation discount

- Homestay or shared apartment: Two students may stay in the same room under one of the following conditions:

Family members

Married or engaged

Same sex high school students coming as a group

The cost for two people is 1.5x the single cost (e.g., for shared apartment, 15,000 yen per week).

- Private apartment: No conditions for two students to stay together. Roughly 8,000 yen per week surcharge for second person.

Additional Services

Airport pickup: 6,000 yen

(As Fukuoka Airport is in the middle of the city, and only 10 minutes by subway from most locations, we do not recommend airport pickup for most students. It is usually cheaper to take a taxi.)

Services Bookable After Student Arrives in Japan

Bicycle rentals: 500 yen per week

Cellphone rentals: 500 yen per week (Students must buy calling credit from convenience stores, but incoming calls are completely free, even from abroad.)

Events: price varies. GenkiJACS runs between 2 and 4 extra-curricular events per week, including parties, festivals, visits to sightseeing places, movie nights, cultural classes and more.
