

## ICC 2008 Program Offerings

**English for Communications (EC):** This 8-level program helps students communicate in both written and spoken English with a focus on basic skills. Study full or part time. High Intermediate and Advanced classes are held in the morning, Beginning and Low-Intermediate in the afternoon.

**English for Business (EB):** Helps students to develop more effective oral and written skills for business situations. There is extensive reading of business articles, speech presentations, writing business letters and resumes, and grammar review. Topics include: Sales & Marketing, Management, Travel & Tourism, Finance & Investment, and Entrepreneurship. Morning classes.

**\*Minimum of 8 weeks enrollment recommended.**

**Internship in Hawaii:** Intensive 8~12 week internship program that combine English language training in the mornings (EB or EC) with on-the-job exposure to American business practices in the afternoons. Interns are placed at a business or professional organization for 8 to 12 hrs/week. All positions are unpaid. The initial 2~3 weeks of this program are spent on internship placement, resume writing and interview practice sessions.

**\*Requires pre-test and phone interview.**

**TOEFL 1 & 2:** Prepares students to excel on the TOEFL test and for success in U.S. universities.

**\*Official TOEFL test required every other month.**

**\*Minimum of 4 weeks enrollment recommended.**

**TOEIC:** Prepares students for success with the TOEIC test, the standard for workplace English language proficiency. *Available as an elective.*

**Extended Stay Program:** A one year program, 36 weeks of English study divided into 3 semesters with two month inter-session breaks, giving students the opportunity to travel or volunteer. Students may pay in three installments.

**College Studies Program (TOEFL 3):** Offered in partnership with Upper Iowa University, students may take up to five **12 week courses for college credit:** English 101 & 102, Psychology, Public Speaking, and Sociology. Complete all classes for a Certificate in American Studies. All credits are transferable to accredited universities.

**\*Requires TOEFL 520/190 or ICC pre-test.**

**Cambridge Preparation:** This program prepares students for success on either the Cambridge First Certificate Exam (FCE) or the Cambridge Advanced Exam (CAE). Allow one extra week after completion of the course for examinations.

**\*ICC entrance pre-test required.**

Winter Intensive (9 weeks): Jan 7 ~ Mar 7 (test 3/8)

Spring Program (12 weeks): Mar 17 ~ June 6 (test 6/12)

Fall Program (12 weeks): Sept 15 ~ Dec 5 (test 12/11)

**ESL Teacher Training (CELTA):** Certificate in English Language Teaching to Adults (CELTA) is a 4 week (40+ hours/week) introductory course for candidates who have little or no previous English language teaching experience.

**\*Requires pre-entry telephone interview and study, and a \$250, 50% refundable deposit.**

**\*Start Dates: June 2, July 7, August 11, Sept 15**

**Teen Summer Adventure:** This exciting and fun program gives teenagers (13-17 years) the opportunity to study English in the mornings and participate in a variety of cultural and sports activities in the afternoons. The program is offered as a group tour package only, for groups of 10 students or more. Please contact us for information, we can custom design a program to match the needs of your group.
