In this high-powered program, students develop more effective oral and written skills for business situations. Through this program, students improve their general language skills with extensive reading of business articles, preparing speech presentations, writing business correspondence, practicing useful business idioms, and reviewing grammar. Each term, the class also focuses on specific business topics, such as sales and marketing, management, finance and investment, banking, or entrepreneurship.

As with all ICC classes, good oral communication skills are of primary importance. As such, students in English for Business have numerous opportunities to speak. Activities to encourage speaking include pair and small group discussions, negotiating, debates, role-plays and speech presentations.

Internship Elective (Placement fee required)

As an added bonus for full-time students only, this 8-week, afternoon program allows students to work in unpaid positions at a company, where they can observe American business practices and use their language skills while interacting on a professional level with co-workers. At ICC, the students attend workshops in preparing resumés, practicing interview techniques, and discussing real and hypothetical workplace case studies. Schedule

Classes are held in the morning from 8:30-12:30. Students can enroll full-time (20 hours/week) or part-time (16 hours/week).

Course Length

Although students can study for a minimum of two weeks, 8 to 12-weeks is recommended.

Entry Requirements

High Intermediate level or submission of one of the following test scores: IELTS - 5+, TOEFL – 450+, TOEIC – 600+. Lower level students must have at least one year business experience and/or consent of the instructor.

The Extended Stay Program allows students to study English for one year with 2 eight week breaks in study to allow for travel (home or to mainland U.S.), volunteer opportunities, internship or cultural activities. Students in this program may study in one or more of the following four English classes:

- 1) English for Communication
- 2) English for Business
- 3) TOEFL
- 4) TOEIC

The one year schedule of study is normally as follows:

- 1) Study - 12 weeks
- 2) No Study - 8 weeks
- 3) Study - 12 weeks
- 4) No Study - 8 weeks
- 5) Study - 12 weeks

There is a total of 36 study weeks in this program

Please Note the special requirements for this program:

- 1) Payment may be made in three installments prior to the beginning of each 12 week study session.
- 2) If an F-1 student cancels their study after an 8 week study break and before the program is completed, they will be required to leave the U.S. as soon as possible and will be charged a \$250 Cancellation Fee against any refund due to the student.

ICC's Super-Intensive course combines 20 hours per week in the **English for Communication** course with 5 hours per week in ICC's computer lab using **TALL**, the newest innovation in English language learning software and technology.

English for Communication is by far our most popular program with 8 levels of language ability to guarantee a match with each student's needs. Students improve their listening, speaking, reading and writing skills with intensive language study. Classes are small with 8 -14 students to allow personal attention. All students study 20 hours/week.

Technology Assisted Language Learning (TALL) is the newest innovation in English language learning software and technology. ICC is the only language school in Honolulu to offer this to English language students. Adding 5 hours of TALL to the study program allows students to:

- Spend an extra hour each day building on their language skills with a computer program that adapts to their learning needs.
- Review and improve in the areas that are most difficult.
- Measure the speed and accuracy of their responses.
- Study at their own pace and comfort level.
- Get individualized attention from a TALL instructor.

Schedule

This super-intensive course combines 20 hours per week of intensive classroom study (4 hours/day, Monday ~ Friday) with 5 hours per week of **TALL** language study in ICC's computer lab. EC classes are held 8:30~12:30 for intermediate to advanced students and 1:00~5:00 for beginning students. Additional hours of **TALL** study time may be purchased separately.

Intercultural Communications College offers a unique American academic study program for serious students. In this distinctive three-level program, students excel at Academic English and get on the fast track to success in American colleges and universities. Each level has a specific emphasis:

TOEFL 1: INTRODUCTION provides students with TOEFL scores less than 133 (450) with the essential knowledge and skills necessary to attend most American vocational schools and many junior and community colleges.

TOEFL 2: FOUNDATION is specially designed for students with official or institutional TOEFL scores of 133 (450) or higher. Over 12 weeks, the curriculum includes 4 weeks of writing, 4 weeks of reading and 4 weeks of academic listening along with a continuous review of grammar, structure and vocabulary. Students also learn about American college life while researching and applying to at least five American colleges or universities.

TOEFL 3: ADVANCED is intended for students with an official or institutional TOEFL score of 190 (520) or higher. All international students interested in studying at the undergraduate (bachelor - BA/BS), graduate (master - MA/MS), doctoral (PhD) or professional (for example, medical, nursing, legal) levels in the USA would benefit from this program. In this program, students may earn up to 21 or more credit hours of fully transferable college courses, such as English Composition, College Math, Introductory Psychology, Western Civilization US History, Public Speaking, Art, or English for Health Professionals.

Students who have successfully completed TOEFL 2 or TOEFL 3 have gone on to study successfully at schools such as University of Arizona, University of Pennsylvania, University of California, Hawaii Pacific University, and University of Hawaii.

Schedule

Classes for TOEFL 2 and 3 are held in the morning from 8:30-12:30, Monday to Friday, while TOEFL 1 classes are in the afternoon from 1:00-5:00.

The Test of English for International Communication (TOEIC) is an English language proficiency test that measures the skills of people who work or wish to work in an international business environment.

Initially developed for Japan's Ministry of Foreign Trade and Industry, TOEIC is used around the world by an expanding number of companies to recruit and promote employees as well as determine the suitability of an employee for an overseas assignment. In Europe alone, 2000 companies rely on TOEIC for their personnel decisions.

ICC is an official test site and offers a preparation course that teaches the strategies for obtaining good scores on both the listening and reading sections of the test. During each four-week term, the course focuses on a different language skill. In addition, students improve their overall proficiency by studying and practicing a variety of grammar structures and practical business-related vocabulary.

Practice tests are provided every Friday and the official test is administered on the last Thursday of each term. Our average TOEIC student can gain as much as 123 points in three months. Students receive a certificate from TOEIC and a proficiency description that would be valuable for any résumé.

Schedule

Classes are held in the afternoon from 1:00-5:00. Students can enroll full-time (20 hours/week) or part-time (16 hours/week).

Course Length

Although students can study for a minimum of four weeks, a 12-week course of study is recommended.

English for Communication Program (EC)

English for Communication (EC), by far our most popular program, helps students of all levels improve their general English skills. Students in the EC program are adults of all ages and come from all over the world. Students study in classes of 8 to 14 students.

The EC program focuses on listening and speaking skills, but also helps students improve their reading and writing abilities. Students learn English through group work, pair work, presentations, homework and testing

Students are placed in one of the 8 levels of classes, based on their placement test scores. All students receive a grammar book and a listening and speaking book. Full-time students have special elective classes as part of the curriculum for 4 hours/week.

All students are tested every four weeks. Students who score well on the tests and demonstrate competence in class are able to move up to the next level at the end of the four week term. Students are also able to transfer to any of the other programs offered at ICC.

The EC program helps many beginning level students prepare for ICC programs that require a higher level of English, such as the TOEFL or English for Business programs. Over the years, many students have moved from ICC's lower level beginning classes to intermediate and advanced classes, transferred to the other specialized courses, and then finally gone on to American colleges or universities in Hawaii and on the Mainland.

Schedule

Classes are held 8:30-12:30 for intermediate to advanced students and 1:00-5:00 for beginning students. Students can enroll full-time (20 hours/week) or part-time (16 hours/week).

Entry Requirements

At least 18 years old and submission of an application form.
