1. Intensive Exam Preparation Course – CELI 3

This course is specifically designed for students aiming to obtain CELI 3 Certificate of the University for Foreigners of Perugia (member of ALTE – Association of Language Testers in Europe).

Students should have **an upper-intermediate level** (Council of Europe Level B2) when starting the course.

We strongly suggest taking the CELI 3 exam to:

- students enrolling at an Italian University or on a Masters course in Italy
- students wishing to certify their knowledge of Italian for work purposes
- students who already work and live in Italy and need an official language certification

CELI 3 Certificate is required to enter Italian Universities without having to take the Italian language entry test.

Course features

- 4 week course
 - 2 hours per day, in the afternoon, 40 hours in total
 - Can be combined with lessons in the morning
 - Start date in May

Course contents

The course concentrates on developing the wide range of skills needed to pass the exam.

Students are constantly monitored and given advice on how to improve their abilities.

The course also aims to develop the techniques and strategies needed to overcome the difficulties students might encounter during the exam.

Exam sessions

CELI 3 takes place on fixed dates in June and November each year. The exam can be taken at IH Milano, which is an authorised University of Perugia examination centre.

Exam contents

CELI 3 has five papers – Reading, Writing, Use of Italian, Listening and Speaking.

2. Full Immersion – One to One

The “Full Immersion” course has been specifically created for those people who must improve their level of Italian in a short period of time and have specific linguistic needs. It is also ideal for people who need Italian for work purposes.

Course features

- 35 hour programme
- Monday to Friday full immersion
- Can start any Monday
- All levels

Course contents

Classes can be focused on either general Italian or professional Italian in the following fields:

Business
Fashion
Music
Finance
Law
Medicine

A combined programme of general and professional Italian is also possible. At an extra cost students can choose to have lunch with the teacher.

Out of school opportunities

On demand, the school can organise interactive lessons outside the school to give the student the opportunity to practice Italian in real-life situations such as at the bank, the post office, the bar or the train station.

It is also possible to take classes outside the school with a teacher in a more relaxed context to explore the cultural side of the city, such as a visit to Brera Art Gallery, the Last Supper by Leonardo da Vinci or the Sforza Castle.

It is ideal for those students who wish to combine an Italian language learning experience with one of IED's programmes in Milan.

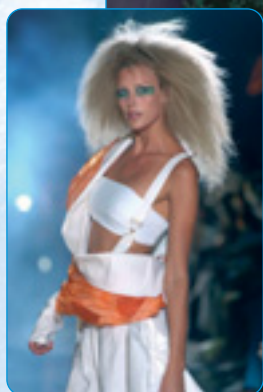
The course concentrates on the study of the Italian language, and develops the skills of listening, writing, grammar and most of all speaking and communication.
