If your flight arrives at Terminal 1 or 2, the Kings School guide will meet you in the arrivals hall. If your flight arrives in Terminal 3, please collect your luggage and follow the signs to Terminal 1 (about a 10-minute walk). Please go to the Terminal 1 Information Desk and ask for the Kings School Bournemouth guide.

# Frequently asked questions

## How can I register / pay for a course?

You can book your course either directly with the school or through a local agent in your own country. If you want to have a list of your local agents, please contact the school.

To register for a course, please complete the Kings registration form on page 18. The registration form can also be found on our website: [www.kingsgroup.co.uk](http://www.kingsgroup.co.uk) or faxed or emailed to you.

Registrations can only be confirmed when we have received a deposit of £170 (£120 deposit and £50 registration fee) or the full fees. Please note that full fees must be paid if you book less than 4 weeks in advance. Kings accepts payment by Credit Card, Cheque or Bank Transfer. Further information on payment can be found on page 17.

Kings will email, fax or post a course confirmation letter / visa letter and an invoice 2-3 working days after receiving your registration form and payment (this may take a little longer in the summer).

## Do I need a visa?

To find out whether you require a visa please visit the UKVisas website at [www.ukvisas.gov.uk/](http://www.ukvisas.gov.uk/) and complete the questions. If you do need a visa, the site will give you instructions on how and where to apply. ## Is insurance included?

Travel insurance is not included in the cost of the course. If required, you can buy insurance from your travel organiser or from Kings. Kings offers insurance for £30 per month, this covers medical / travel / cancellation fees.

## Can I open a bank account?

For students who will be in the UK for over 6 months it is usually possible to open a UK bank account. Kings Bournemouth also offers an internal bank service for students who have difficulty opening an account.

## Can Kings arrange my airport transfer?

Yes! Airport transfers are included on some courses. If an airport transfer is not included, you can still book a transfer. Please see page 14 for prices and information. Please remember to send us your flight details at least 7 days in advance.

## Will my class be international?

Yes! Kings accepts students from throughout the world, so there could be students from any country adding a huge amount of cultural diversity to our courses. We ensure that all of our classes are as mixed as possible to give students the opportunity to meet people from other countries and practise their English as much as possible!

## What happens on my first day at school?

Outside the Summer, all new students should come to school at 08.45 on Monday morning (or Tuesday morning if Monday is a public holiday). On your first day, you will have a language test, a welcome talk and a tour of the school. In the summer, students at Kings London and Oxford should come to school on Monday morning as above. Students at Kings Bournemouth are usually tested on Sunday morning during July and August (your homestay will confirm this) and then have an orientation on Monday.

## Will I have an English test when I arrive?

Yes! Your English will be tested upon arrival at the school to ascertain your level. You will also have regular tests throughout your course to measure your progress and move you to a higher level if necessary. Please note that students on Business English Courses will have a needs analysis instead of a test.

## Will I get a certificate at the end of my course?

Yes! All students who attend at least 80% of their lessons receive a certificate. Our certificates are linked to the Common European Framework "can-do" statements.

## Can I work whilst in the UK?

This will depend on your visa and nationality. Kings does offer a series of Work Placement courses for students who want to come over specifically to work whilst studying. Information can be found on page 13.

## Can I change my homestay?

If you have a genuine problem, it is usually possible to change your homestay (please note that homestay changes usually take place at the weekend). If you wish to move from a homestay into private accommodation, you will need to give the school / family at least 2 weeks' notice.

## How far are homestay from the school?

Most homestay accommodation at King's Oxford and London is within walking distance of the school (10-25 minutes' walk), except in the busy summer months when some homestay will be located a short bus ride away. In Bournemouth, about 60% of homestays are within walking distance in the winter and about 20% in the summer.

## What other types of accommodation are available?

In addition to standard homestay we also offer:

Kings Bournemouth - Executive homestay (with private bathroom) and self-catering student residence (summer only)

Kings London - Executive homestay (with private bathroom)

Kings Oxford - Student residence just 300 metres from the school (single rooms, half-board, summer only)

# Course and Accommodation Notes and Terms and Conditions

## Course and Accommodation Notes

- Lessons are taught by teachers who hold a specialist qualification in teaching English to foreign students. All courses include a level assessment on or prior to arrival, induction and orientation, regular progress tests and a Kings certificate of achievement for students who successfully complete the course. Teaching materials are provided by the school.
- Beginners are accepted on the Intensive Course / Summer Intensive / Summer Vacation / Summer Extra Courses at Kings Bournemouth / London but **MUST** start on the first Monday on the month (**beginners who arrive at other times will have individual lessons and be charged accordingly**).
- Accommodation prices are per week (7 nights). No refund is given for early departure but a charge will be made for any extra nights.
- Some of Kings homestays sometimes host 4 or more adult students. In this case, the homestay is officially a "private home" and there may be less direct contact with the hosts.
- Twin rooms are subject to availability. If a twin room is not available, Kings reserves the right to place the student in a single room and charge accordingly. Twin rooms are international unless the student requests to share with a friend or relative.

## Terms and conditions

- Please see pages 10 and 11 for conditions relating to A-level and Foundation courses.
- Enrolment Fee: There is a £50 registration fee payable on all courses.
- Public examination fees are not included in course prices.
- Kings reserves the right to change prices / course timetables, etc. at any time prior to registration.
- Christmas / New Year: The schools are closed from Saturday 20 December 2008 to Sunday 4 January 2009.
- Courses start on Monday (or Tuesday if Monday is a public holiday). Students may miss 2-5 lessons in their first week as testing and orientation is usually done on the student's first day at school.
- Public holidays: Tuition is not given on public holidays (March 21, 24, May 5, 26, August 25.). No refund or compensation is given for lessons missed due to public holidays.
- Timetable: Lessons on adult courses usually run from Monday to Friday but summer courses may include lessons on Saturdays.
- Acceptance of registration: written acceptance of registration by the school constitutes a firm agreement for the period specified on the registration form.
- Payment: Full fees must be received 4 weeks before the start of the course (if registration is received less than 4 weeks before the start of the course, full payment must be made at the time of registration).
- Class expulsion / exclusion: The Principals and Directors of Studies reserve the right to exclude from class any student who, for reasons of general misconduct, lack of ability, poor discipline, poor progress or poor attendance is not qualified to enter that class. No refund is due in the case of expulsion. Travel and other costs incurred as a result of expulsion must be met by the student or by the student's guardian.
- Liability: Kings Schools UK shall not be liable under any circumstance for its failure to provide any services whatsoever if that failure is caused directly or indirectly by industrial action.
- Any damage to School property, whether intentional or not, will be charged to the student responsible.
- Accommodation: Kings acts solely as agents (and not as principals) in the arranging and providing of homestay accommodation for students.
- Holidays for long-term students: Students are permitted a maximum of 2 weeks' holiday during a 24-week course and a maximum of 3 weeks' holiday during a 36-week course. Holidays must be taken as one block and must be booked at least 4 weeks in advance. An administration fee will be charged for any changes in holiday dates. Full homestay accommodation fees will be charged if the bedroom is not completely vacated. The charge for storing luggage at the homestay is £20 per week.
- Holidays for short-term students: No allowance is made for students taking holiday during their course (i.e. no refund will be given for days missed and days missed cannot be added to the end of the course).
- Jurisdiction: For any dispute arising out of this contract, the parties expressly agree to submit to the jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales having jurisdiction in the matter in question.

## Cancellation / Withdrawals / Late Arrivals

- All cancellations / withdrawals must be notified in writing to the school.
- Bank charges: Bank charges will be deducted from any refund given.
- Cancellations received more than 4 weeks in advance: All courses - Kings will arrange a refund of all fees paid except £50 registration fee + any associated bank charges. Special conditions apply to A-Level and Foundation courses, please see pages 10 and 11.
- Cancellations received less than 4 weeks in advance due to visa refusal (applies to all courses): on receipt of a visa refusal letter from the relevant consulate / embassy, Kings will arrange a refund of all fees paid except £50 registration fee + any associated bank charges.
- Cancellations received less than 4 weeks in advance due to other reasons: No refund for long-term Intensive / Compact courses where the student has paid the reduced price for long-term courses indicated by an asterisk (\*) in the price list. No refund for University Access Course or Summer Camps. Special conditions apply to A-Level and Foundation courses, please see pages 10 and 11. For other courses Kings will arrange a refund of all fees paid except £170 (combined deposit / registration) + any associated bank charges.
- Withdrawals: Four weeks' notice in writing must be given for withdrawals from a course. No refund for long-term Intensive / Compact Courses where the student has paid the reduced price for long-term courses indicated by an asterisk (\*) in the price list. No refund for University Access / Foundation Year / Pre-Foundation Year / GCE A-levels.
- Late arrivals: No fees are refundable in the case of late arrivals for a course.

## Registration

- Registrations can only be confirmed when we have received a deposit of £170 (£120 deposit and £50 registration fee) or the full fees. Please note that full fees must be paid if you book less than 4 weeks in advance.
- Kings will fax, post or email a course confirmation letter, invoice and visa letter (if required) 2-3 working days after receiving your registration form and payment (this may take a little longer in the summer).
- The homestay address and airport transfer confirmation are usually sent 3 - 10 days before arrival. Please note that if you register less than 10 days in advance, you will receive the homestay address on arrival.
- Please check all correspondence carefully and notify us immediately if there are any queries or changes.

## Payment by Credit Card

- **Please note that a 2% surcharge applies to credit card bookings.**
- Please fill in your credit card details on the registration form.
- **Please note that if you pay only the deposit when you book your course, the balance for the full cost of the course will automatically be debited from your credit card 4 weeks before the start of the course unless we receive payment by an alternative method.**

## Payment by Cheque

- Kings accepts sterling cheques and euro cheques. If sending a euro cheque, please ensure that sufficient euros are sent to cover the sterling value and the bank conversion rates. Please fax a copy and post the original cheque to the school you have selected.
