Your English Course



English World Courses

- Improve your knowledge, skills and confidence in using English
- Learn to communicate in everyday situations
- Personalise your course to suit you

English World courses are suitable for students who want to improve their all round skills and performance in English. Our lessons are lively with a variety of different activities, helping you to make fast progress.

In the mornings, speaking, listening, reading and writing are integrated in a carefully structured programme. In the afternoons, you choose a Study Option which focuses on developing particular language skills (e.g. Listening and Pronunciation, Communication Skills, Grammar, Vocabulary), or you may choose Business English Skills or an examination course (IELTS, TOEIC or BEC).

English World courses start every Monday (except when the school is closed, when courses start on Tuesday). They are suitable for all abilities from Elementary to Advanced. Choose a course which suits you:

English World 26

Our English World 26 lesson course is what we recommend to most students. It is an intensive course with 20 lessons in the morning and 6 Study Option lessons in the afternoons. This enables your all round skills to develop in the morning, with a particular focus on your weaknesses or special interests in the afternoons.

English World Combination 26

Make your course even more intensive by adding 4 extra one to one lessons to our English World 26 course. This highly personalised course enables you to focus on an area that you would like additional help with.

English World 20

Study for 20 lessons each week in the mornings, leaving you free to relax, learn in our Study Centre, or explore British life and culture after lunch. Please note that lessons are taught on alternate mornings and afternoons for courses between 25 Jun-24 Aug.

English World Internship

On these courses you study in our school for 4-23 weeks and then take an unpaid internship programme of 4-23 weeks. Brush up your English skills, make friends, build your confidence and then move into the world of work to use your new found skills and enhance your CV. The English World Internship course includes 2 individual lessons to help you prepare for interview and work experience. On this course visa nationals must take the University of Cambridge International Examinations Certificate in Work Experience. Non-visa nationals may take the University of Cambridge certificate or our in-house work experience certificate.

Long Term and Examination Courses

Academic Year (AYP) and Academic Semester (ASP) Programmes

The Academic Year and Semester programmes are carefully designed to help your English develop well over 6 or 9 months. Your programme is planned so you study effectively, improve your English and take at least one recognised examination (IELTS or Cambridge – any examination fees are not included in the price).

There are 32 weeks of tuition on an AYP, and 24 weeks of tuition on an ASP. You may extend your course by adding four weeks of holiday on an AYP, and two weeks on an ASP. We offer a full time programmes of 26 lessons per week, or a part time course of 20 lessons. Choose our 26 lesson courses for the fastest improvement in your English.

Academic Semester Internship and Academic Year Internship

On these courses you study in our school for 24 or 32 weeks and then take an unpaid internship programme for at least 4 weeks. The cost of a 4 week internship programme is included in the price of the Academic Semester or Academic Year programme. A longer internship of up to 24 weeks is available at a weekly supplement. This course makes the perfect gap year - improve your English, make friends and build your confidence and then move into the world of work to use your new found skills and enhance your CV. On this course visa national students must take the University of Cambridge International Examinations Certificate in Work Experience; non-visa nationals must take the Regent work experience certificate.



Cambridge Examination Courses

We offer a range of courses to prepare you for examinations. Required course materials are not included on these courses and are available at a supplementary fee.

Cambridge First Certificate (FCE), Cambridge Advanced English (CAE)

The First Certificate (FCE) course is designed for Intermediate students; the Cambridge Advanced (CAE) courses are for Advanced students. These courses are suitable for students who want a structured course and an internationally recognised qualification. Courses are for 10 or 12 weeks and consist of 26 lessons per week with examination skills taught in the afternoons.

IELTS Exam Preparation Course

Prepare for the IELTS English test that allows entry to universities in Britain, Canada and Australia. Your course consists of 6 afternoon Study Option lessons of IELTS preparation with 20 lessons of general English in the morning. The IELTS examination fee is at extra cost - please book exam places well in advance.

One to One Courses Elite Individual

Take an individual course to make the fastest possible progress. 20, 30 or 40 one to one lesson courses are available for clients requiring the most intensive programmes.

Your accommodation

We know how important your accommodation is and so we offer a choice. Many students choose homestay - living with local people in their own home. You can have a single room, with somewhere to study. Your accommodation provides an ideal opportunity to practise English outside class.

Private home (where there are more than 3 students) accommodation is sometimes available. Alternatively, we can arrange hotel accommodation.



Language and Leisure

Our Language and Leisure social and activity programme is designed to help you have fun, make new friends and to discover modern local culture. Often accompanied by your teachers or other school staff, this is the perfect way to have a great time with your friends, practise your English and experience our authentic local culture. At least two events each week are free.

Taking an internship

After taking an English language course we provide an opportunity to practise your English skills in a real life working environment while gaining experience of the working world. Taking an internship enables you to put all the English skills you have learnt during your course to good use in a professional environment. You learn new vocabulary, work alongside native speakers and get to know more about British working culture too.

All students who have entered the UK on a Student Visa or who are EU citizens may take unpaid work experience. If you are an EU student you may take a placement after your language course. For non-EU students your placement must be a minimum of 4 weeks and not longer than your English course. You must be over 18 years old, have intermediate level English or IELTS level 5 before you start the placement, and, for most positions, have a college course or previous work experience in the industry in which you wish to be placed.



University Counselling Service

We offer a free educational counselling service to our students. Our educational counsellor assesses your skills and advises you on the best courses and universities for you. You can meet representatives from universities at our mini fairs to discuss your plans. We provide help with the application process and advise you on what academic and IELTS grades are required for each university course.





Terms and Conditions

1. Enrolment

- Full fees or the deposit of £300 must be paid to us before we can reserve a place or book accommodation.
- All fees must be paid to us 30 days before the course starts.
- If full payment has not been received by the course start date, the student will not be admitted to class and will have to leave any accommodation booked through us.

2. Services

In the event of circumstances beyond our control, we may change the services offered, including details of locations, courses, facilities and dates of programmes. Where the number of students at any level is insufficient to form a viable group, we may provide group lessons at a different time of day or location, or one to one lessons. Alternatives provided will be of equivalent or greater financial value.

Lessons are held at our school buildings or at alternative premises nearby. There may be occasional closed groups of juniors.

3. Refund Policy

- By "one week's fees", we mean tuition and accommodation charges for 1 week.
- If a visa application is rejected and we are given written evidence at least 8 days before the start of the course, we will refund the fees received in full. With fewer than 8 days' notice, we charge 1 week's accommodation fees.
- No fees are refunded if a student cancels or curtails their course on or after the start date.
- If a student decides to cut short a course or change from a more expensive course to a cheaper one, there are no refunds.
- A credit on tuition is considered in cases of serious illness or bereavement in the immediate family, providing we receive documentary evidence.
- We may charge a booking amendment fee of £30 if you change the course or accommodation you originally booked.
- If there are changes to accommodation arrangements during the course, or requests for a student holiday, students must give at least two full weeks' notice, beginning at a weekend.
- On a long term (24+ weeks) course, students may choose to move to another Regent managed school after a minimum of 10 weeks at the first school. Students must give at least two full weeks' notice, beginning at a weekend.
- Where we cancel or defer a course, all fees will be refunded. Refunds are paid in your home country. If you enrolled through a representative the refund will be paid to your representative.

4. Medical and Travel Insurance

- Students must have appropriate Medical and Travel Insurance and must either take out insurance through us or provide proof of adequate cover at the time of enrolment.
- As cover starts when we receive payment, please pay the insurance fee when enrolling.

5. Public Holidays

There are no lessons on days which are public holidays. Students are offered replacement lessons on other days in the same week.

6. Resolution of Disputes

If any student is unhappy with any aspect of the course, they should contact the Principal on site. If they are still not satisfied, they should write to Scanbrit's Head Office. We will investigate the complaint if:

- we receive it within 28 days after the end of the course
- it was given in writing to the Principal before the student left
- we have received all fees due

7. Liability

Our company, staff or representatives are not liable:

- for any loss, damage or injury to people or property or as a result of consequential losses, except where we have a liability under UK law
- when we cannot provide services or programmes for any reason in our UK schools

Scanbrit School of English is an intermediary between its students and travel organisations on the one hand, and homestays or other accommodation providers, and any extra-curricular or off-site services on the other. Under no circumstances can Scanbrit School of English be held responsible for any delay, accident or loss which may happen during the student's stay with the homestay or other accommodation provider, or during any extra-curricular or off-site activity.

Scanbrit School of English will, however, endeavour to defend the student's interests in the event of breach of contract on the part of the travel organisation, the homestay or other accommodation provider, or extra-curricular or off-site service.

8. Conduct of Students

- All students must follow the rules of each course, and follow our instructions.
- We may expel any student for behaviour which is unacceptable, including unsatisfactory attendance. In such cases we will not return fees and the student will have to pay any additional travel or other costs.
- Students whose attendance puts them in breach of visa regulations (80% attendance) will be reported to the UK Home Office.
- Students who cause damage will have to pay the full cost of replacement or repair.
- Students who are under the school minimum age limit will not be admitted and will be asked to return home at their own expense.

9. Statutory Rights

These terms and conditions will be interpreted as per UK law. Our terms and conditions do not affect your statutory rights under UK law.
