English Language Courses for Adult Students

Registration fee

£57

This fee is charged on all enrolments to cover administration expenses, book to take home, TSE Online e-learning for 12 months, TSE student card and basic social programme of 2 evenings per week, Thursday afternoon workshop and sports activity.

We only charge **£36** per enrolment for returning students or for second and further members of the same family attending a course at the same time.

Course Information

Fees include: Tuition, loan of course materials, testing and orientation, welcome pack, weekly teacher-led self-access sessions, monthly tutorials and tests for long-term students and certificate of attendance.

Use of school internet facilities: There are 8 computers for free internet access outside class times. We also have a wireless network so students can bring their own laptops for free internet access.

Start dates: any Monday unless specified; first Monday of the month if possible.

Minimum course length: 2 weeks unless otherwise specified.

Minimum level: Elementary (beginners by arrangement only)

Daily schedules (Monday to Friday):

Standard English:	09.00 – 12.30
Intensive English, Exam Preparation and Teachers courses:	09.00 – 15.00 (Lunch 12.30 – 13.30)
Mini Groups:	09.00 – 14.30 (Lunch 12.30 – 13.30)

Lesson length: 45 minutes, held in blocks of 1.5 hours (except afternoon Mini groups or One-to-Ones).

Minimum age: 17 years (unless otherwise stated). In certain circumstances we will accept students aged 16 years.

High season: Monday 29th June to Friday 21st August 2009.

School closing times: 1st January, 10th April, 13th April, 4th May, 25th May, 31st August, 25th and 26th December (Public Holidays). We are also closed for the Christmas period -2 weeks from Friday 19th December to Friday 2nd January 2010. School opens again on Monday 4th January 2010.

Long-term reduction: **10% reduction on tuition fees for any course of 12 weeks or more.**

Payment: We accept payment by bank transfer, credit/debit card, sterling cheque and cash.

7. Four afternoons per week unpaid work placement in local charity shops, businesses and companies. Placement fee includes sourcing, interview and company reference for 1-8 weeks part-time work experience.
8. For 2-4 students, three afternoons per week (total 6 clock hours) outside the classroom with a teacher practising your English in real-life situations in small groups.
9. For 2-4 students, three afternoon workshops per week (total 6 hours) in creative arts (such as batik, water-colour painting, photography, pastels, acrylic, candle-making etc) with an art teacher. English language support from one of our English teachers.
10. For 2-4 students, three afternoon workshops per week (total 6 hours) in different therapies (such as aromatherapy, reiki, shiatsu, yoga, reflexology and more) with accredited local therapists. English language support from one of our English teachers.
11. For 2-4 students, two afternoon trips (one garden and one castle per week for a total of 6 hours) to practise your English with an English teacher at the same time as experiencing the magic of an English country garden and the drama of our historic castles. (Available Monday 30th March – Friday 30th October 2009).
12. If you are the only student booked for this course, you will receive two afternoons per week (total 4 clock hours) doing the activities on a One-to-One basis.
